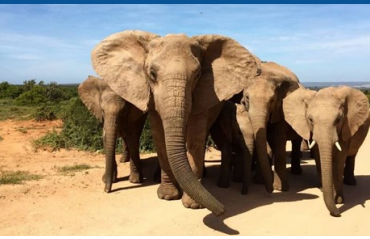

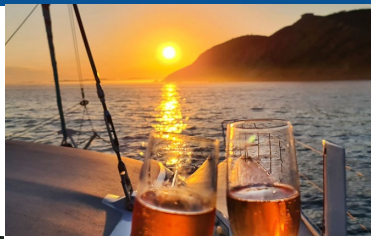

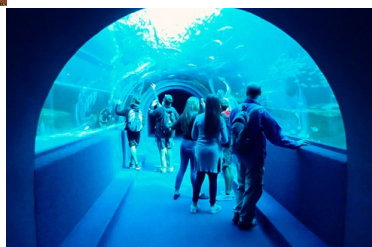


**Huguenot Chocolate Tasting**
